Primate viewing safari

80 miles south of where explorers Stanley and Livingstone first met, wild chimpanzees make their home in the Mahale mountain forests near Lake Tanganyika. There are no roads in this park. Humans enter only on foot or travel along the coast by boat.

DAYS 1-3

Greystoke Mahale or Mbali Mbali Lodge Mahale Mountains National Park

Depart Arusha and arrive at Mahale Mountains National Park bush airstrip where lodge staff await you. Board a traditional dhow boat and travel along the coastline of Lake Tanganyika to the camp on the edge of Mahale Forest. Enjoy the tranquility of an environment where you trade the busy roar of traffic for the songs of forest birds and the sound of the breeze blowing on the water.

Rise early for breakfast and trek alongside your guide into the forests of Mahale. Trackers send word when they have spotted the chimps. These chimpanzees have been habituated for many years by a group of researchers from Kyoto University. Their efforts offer the opportunity to enjoy close encounters with the chimps and to sit quietly and observe their family life as it unfolds around you.

Look for abundant bird life and butterflies, as well as other primates such as the Angola colobus, red colobus, red-tailed monkeys and blue monkeys in the trees.

Trek chimpanzees on *Day 2*
and then again on *Day 3*.
