




Samburu has some unique animals for viewing rarely found together in other parks. The gerenuk is an antelope with a giraffe-like neck, adapted to browsing in bushes—a niche not exploited by most other animals. The Beisa oryx survives this hot climate by cooling the blood flowing to its brain, as it passes through capillaries in its nose. Other unique species in this incredible wildlife environment include the Reticulated giraffe, the Grevy zebra and the Somali ostrich.

This part of Kenya has been on the forefront of research on elephant migration patterns and corridors. Dr. Iain Douglas-Hamilton and his Elephant Watch camp are based in the area. Mapping elephant migration corridors, their GPS data helps to prevent conflicts between elephants and humans. Local farmers and pastoralists have an easier time protecting their crops, livestock and families because of the work done by Save the Elephants.




Board a bush flight to the greater Maasai Mara ecosystem, home to the legendary migration crossings of millions of wildebeest.
