

Chobe Elephant Camp Chobe National Park

Chobe Elephant Camp will pick you up at the Kasane Airport and transfer you into camp.

One of the great wildlife destinations on the continent, the Chobe River and surrounding woodlands support an incredible diversity of animals, including more than 50,000 elephants—the largest density of African elephants in the world. Large herds of elephants swim in the river, zebra and buffalo graze on the floodplains and giraffes feed on the acacias. In addition, it has some of the highest predator densities in Botswana and is home to more than three hundred bird species making it a top

birding destination in Botswana.

Overlooking the famous Chobe River, Chobe Elephant Camp provides incredible views and is located on tribal lands of the Sibuya people who inhabit the low lying floodplains between the Chobe River (Botswana) through the Caprivi (Namibia) to the Zambezi River (Zambia). No fences separate people from wildlife. The Sibuya coexist with the wildlife in the area.

This camp overlooks the Gomoti River and it contains wide open floodplains, as well as riverine forest. This is a wonderful habitat for all animals with hooves, so enjoy large herds of buffalo and flocks of birdlife, Rra Dinare means Father Buffalo in Setswana.


The camp is perched on stilts overlooking the flood plains. It's a room with a view, submerged in nature. This area is one of the last water sources available during the dry season so large numbers of wildlife move in and out of the Nxai and Makgadikgadi Pans.

Wildlife viewing Get your checklist ready

Buffalo, Crocodile, Elephant, Genet, Giraffe, Hippo, Impala, Kudu, Tsessebe, Honey Badger and a host of Plains Game. Rare Antelope breeds including Eland, Roan & Sable not normally seen in the Okavango region, occur here. As the Gomoti is the main water source in the area, Cheetah, Leopard, Lion, and Wild Dog.

DAYS 7-9

Kwara Camp Okavango Delta

Kwara Camp brings together 675 square miles (1,086,307 meters) containing both water and land segments on the northeastern edge of the Okavango Delta. Seasonal floodplains and wooded islands surround the camp. There are papyrus waterways and lagoons on the south side of conservancy. Bushveld savanna offers up great cheetah and wild dog sightings. Kwara's water border is shared with the iconic Moremi Game Reserve. All of these different ecosystems leads to a wide diversity of species available for viewing.

At Kwara Camp you have both a tracker and a safari guide, the tracker focused on tracks and signs and the guide on explaining animal behaviors. At Kwara it is all about the wildlife. This camp is 100% citizen owned and the staff is all Botswanan, so every day is an enjoyable cultural immersion into Botswana culture.




