



Nyikani Tarangire Camp Tarangire National Park

After breakfast, drive south to Tarangire National Park, which boasts one of the largest elephant populations in East Africa. Many close-knit elephant families—matriarchs, babies, teenagers and bulls, come together along Tarangire River and the Silale wetlands. Feel their wisdom and deep emotional bonds. Big cats love the rolling savanna here too.

With a range of ecosystems from grassland and woodlands in the north to scrub and wetlands further south Tarangire's incredibly diverse mix of habitat is not found anywhere else in northern Tanzania. A variety of different wildlife species, including big cats, gather at the river making for great viewing year round.

Tarangire is also famous for its giant, otherworldly baobab trees with their massive trunks and crooked branches. Local people ascribe mystical qualities to them because of their long lifespan: 600 - 3,000 years.

DAY 4

Manyara's Secret Lake Manyara National Park

The evergreen groundwater forest of Lake Manyara National Park is set against the Rift Valley. While it looks like a rainforest, there is actually very little rainfall here. Instead, mineral springs seep up through porous volcanic soil. The park contains a variety of ecosystems including acacia woodland, grasslands, swamp delta and of course, the expansive lake. Explore the forest ecosystem through a canopy walk.

Manyara boasts over 380 recorded bird species and is home to the rare tree-climbing lions— an unusual adaptation for these big cats.

DAYS 5-7

Moyo Tented Camp Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, head to awe-inspiring Serengeti National Park.

Moyo Tented Camp is in the Seronera area of the central Serengeti—a 12,000 sq. mile (31,079 sq. km) savanna grassland spanning northern Tanzania and Kenya's Maasai Mara, forming one of the world's largest wildlife refuges.

Seronera is actually a network of perennial rivers that merge into the valley, so there is water to be found year round. The river marks the boundary between the sweet grass plains of the southern Serengeti and the wooded hills of the north. That means there are plant, animal, and bird species from both different habitats in this area.


Big cat viewing is superb in this region of the Serengeti. There are actually twelve different lion prides living within driving distance of the river. Not to be forgotten, the smaller cats such as caracals, servals, and African wild cats definitely make their presence known.

DAYS 8 & 9

Ngorongoro Farm House Ngorongoro Crater

Dry plains rapidly turn to lush coffee plantations and tropical vegetation on the drive from Tarangire to Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area. Ngorongoro is an extinct volcano. Flora thrives on volcanic soil. The top (7,500 ft) boasts a once in a lifetime view into the caldera with some of the best wildlife viewing in East Africa.

Head into the Crater early as dawn brings a wave of activity in the natural world. This ecosystem showcases an astonishing microcosm of East African wildlife environments: grasslands, wetlands, acacia forest and soda lakes. Enjoy lunch at the Hippo Pools, where hippos and elephants wade for a mid-day bath.

Only Maasai people are allowed live in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Notice the Maasai enkangs or "homesteads," while climbing the slopes of the Crater. With special tribal land rights, they live a pastoral life and coexist with the animals.
