





Njozi Camp Serengeti National Park

Cheetahs accelerate from zero to 60mph in just 3 seconds.

The word *Serengeti* means "endless plain." It will be clear why. Serengeti's famous annual wildlife migration stretches more than a thousand miles and is most known for vast herds of wildebeests, zebras and Thomson's gazelles. The herds gather on the Tanzanian side of the ecosystem from approximately November/December through early July. In search of greener grasses, they make their perennial pilgrimage from the Maasai Mara into the Serengeti and back. As the migration herds spill across the Serengeti, witness the greatest wildlife show on the planet.


Ikuka Camp Ruaha National Park


Remote, rugged and wild, Ruaha National Park is built for adventure. Sitting in a transitional zone between the savannas of northern Tanzania and the woodlands common in Zambia, it's uniquely covered with thick vegetation in some areas and open grasslands in others. Sandy intermittent streams flow from the Great Ruaha River. Track wildlife along the river beds. Listen for pangolins in the bush.

Lions here are generally much larger than those in northern Tanzania and many Ruaha prides have as many as 20 members. Cheetahs frequent the grasslands while leopards lie in the more wooded areas, as do smaller predators like spotted hyenas and black-backed jackals. It's the only park to see greater and lesser kudu together.
