Depart Nairobi for southern Kenya's spectacular Amboseli National Park, whose acacia woodland, savannas and marshes are home to a large population of elephants. Researchers have studied Amboseli's elephant population longer than any other and it was here they discovered that elephants have extremely sensitive feet that pick up vocalizations traveling through the ground as seismic waves. With the support of researchers, tourism and local Maasai, Amboseli's elephant population is one of the few whose rate has increased slowly since the late 1970s.

DAYS 4 & 5

Lion Hill Lodge

Lake Nakuru National Park

Lake Nakuru National Park contains a variety of ecosystems— acacia forest, woodlands and a famous soda lake that draws more than 400 species of birds, including large flocks of flamingos.

Lion Hill Lodge sits atop, as the name implies, Lion Hill. There are marvelous views of pelicans fishing and flamingos wading in the lake from the lodge.

Several endangered species thrive near Lake Nakuru, including black and white rhinos and the iconic Rothschild’s giraffe herd, now with 165 members. Predators are limited here, so antelope herds are large and habituated. It’s not uncommon to encounter an antelope roadblock while exploring.

DAYS 6, 7 & 8

Mara Crossings Camp Maasai Mara Game Reserve

Heading west, the landscape changes to drier grasslands and many herds of cattle tended to by young Maasai. One of Africa's classic safari lands, the Maasai Mara Game Reserve is a one of the world's most prolific wildlife destinations year round.

The Mara contains a wide array of habitats with unique flora and fauna. Acacia woodlands attract giraffe. Hippos occupy the deeper river pools. This is one of the world's last cheetah strongholds and has a good number of lions, leopards and smaller cats. At last count, there were 22 lion prides, including the famous Marsh pride.

Mara Crossing Camp



While the Mara boasts superb wildlife viewing all year, from July until late October the great wildebeest migration follows seasonal rains across the Kenyan and Tanzanian savanna.

Hundreds of thousands of wildebeest, zebra and Thomson's gazelle stampede north through the Mara.

Populations of resident wildebeests live in the Mara year round and a secondary east/west migration occurs only in Kenya, between the Loita Plains and the Mara.

The Maa Trust

The Maa Trust works to increase the benefits of wildlife and conservation to Maasai families so that they appreciate and contribute to the protection of wild animals on their land.

The Trust also promotes small business startups & micro finance schemes, measuring these ventures' success by not only how much money is earned, but also on the impact that these earnings have upon the lives of the business owners, workers, and the community. The women who create and work in these projects are investing in clean drinking water for their homes, solar power (limiting the use of firewood and its environmental impact) and their children's education.
