# Lahia Tented Camp

## Serengeti National Park

### Western Corridor

A bush plane takes you deep into the Western Corridor of the Serengeti, where the Grumeti River draws remarkable numbers of wildebeest and zebra of the great migration for just a few weeks out of the year. Here is a vista of wild land as far as the eye can see, crossed by impressive numbers of giraffes, elephants and lions. An expert Deeper Africa guide will show you how this ecosystem works and the intricate web of life it supports. After trekking, return to camp for a welcome massage, a sunset swim in the infinity pool and dinner under the stars as those lions roar in the distance. This is an impressive experience, even by Serengeti standards.

# Nomad Kigelia Camp

## Ruaha National Park

Remote, rugged and wild, Ruaha National Park is built for adventure. Sitting in a transitional zone between the savannas of northern Tanzania and the woodlands common in Zambia, it's uniquely covered with thick vegetation in some areas and open grasslands in others, interlaced with sandy intermittent streams flowing off the Great Ruaha River.

Roughly ten percent of the world's lions live here. Lions in Ruaha are generally much larger than those in northern Tanzania and many Ruaha prides have as many as 20 members. Cheetahs frequent the grasslands while leopards lie in the more wooded areas, as do smaller predators like spotted hyenas and black-backed jackals. It's the only park to see both greater and lesser kudu together.

Ruaha is Tanzania's largest national park and best kept secret. It has very few visitors.

Home to one of Africa's largest elephant populations, zebras, giraffes, large herds of buffalo and antelope, it's baobob-dotted landscapes straddle the Eastern Rift Valley. Rivers & swamps teem with crocodiles and hippos.

# Sand River Selous Nyerere National Park

Nyerere's ecosystems range from open woodlands and plains to the Rufiji River, known for its hippos, crocodiles, and rich birdlife. Boat safaris on the Rufiji offer sightings of buffalo, waterbuck, and impala, while land safaris showcase antelope, elephants, lions, and even African wild dogs. You may also spot one of the two wildebeest species—black-bearded gnu or nyasa wildebeest.
