DAYS 1, 2 & 3

Kiri Camp Okavango Delta

Touch down into this vast wilderness southwest of Chief's Island. Pair a feeling of opulence with consideration for the environment in a camp that runs on solar energy. You're in an environment where expertise in guiding lets the wildlife that roam along the Kiri Channel shine through. Sleeping in the wilds has never been so indulgent.

Your camp is located on the Monachira Channel in the Moremi Game Reserve of the Okavango Delta, a permanent waterway attracting abundant wildlife, including large mammals such as elephants, lions and leopard, as well as semiaquatic antelope. It is very close to the Gudigwa heronries - a nesting ground for thousands of herons, egrets and storks.

Moremi is all about searching for big wildlife. The

habitats are as diverse as the wildlife itself. Water-adapted antelopes and wary-eyed buffaloes spill out into floodplains, behind towering woodlands where leopards hide on the high branches. Dead trees cast silhouettes over elephant filled savannas which are just a stone's throw from papyrus-fringed channels stretching out to the delta beyond.

This tour around Maun is an opportunity to learn about Setswana life, experience its traditions and cultures, and hear firsthand stories about Botswanan life. Your visit makes a difference in Botswanan life by empowering local entrepreneurs and developing new ambassadors.

Learn about local customs and traditions from your local host, intermingled with their own personal experiences. Feast your senses on the sights, smells and sounds when walking through the vibrant market place. Taste some traditional dishes at a local café. Meet some Maun entrepreneurs and try your hand at the ancient practice of basket weaving, as well as hearing about the stories behind the beautiful patterns.
