





DAYS 1, 2 & 3

Chobe Elephant Camp

Chobe National Park

Upon arrival at XXX in Botswana, a Deeper Africa representative will meet you holding a sign with your name on it. They'll transfer you to Chobe Elephant Camp for your drive down to the river.

Chobe Elephant Camp is located on the western side of the Chobe Riverfront known as the Serondela sector, so you'll still be in the park, but away from the crowds of tourists that congregate further east. We want you to have the wilderness, the elephants, and the wildlife all to yourself.

The Chobe Riverfront is an elephant mecca; it is home to more than 50,000 elephants, with the largest density of African elephants in the world. Chobe will leave you feeling positively Lilliputian as giant elephant bulls stroll up to your Land Cruiser, or snorkel off the bow of your boat. You feel lost as hundreds of hippos and buffalo crowd you out on the flood plains. Your heart will sit in your throat as prides of lions stalk antelope by the water's edge, and you will be alone with your thoughts while the classic red sunsets melt over the river as you listen to a soundtrack of whistling fish eagles.

DAYS 4, 5 & 6

Sango Safari Camp Okavango Delta

Departs | Chobe National Park

Arrives | Okavango Delta

Follow the Okavango's water to the edge of the delta. A wonderful mix of ecosystems means substantial diversity in animal viewing. Expect bristling activity in this grassland ecosystem nourished by these life giving waters. Venture out onto the Khwai River in a traditional mokoro and into the lattices of lagoons and winding channels of papyrus that branch off. There is an abundance of malachite kingfishers in these water systems, so you'll see these beautiful birds diving and darting to catch fish. As you glide along in the water look down into the clear water; you can see right down into the sandy bottom of the Kalahari. After dinner, under the stars, gather around a blazing fire to compare notes and share stories.

AGLOW-Pokolong is a Travel for Impact program that helps seniors in Maun. Government programs like Meals on Wheels don't exist here. But through this program, community members pitch in to help as needed with housekeeping and transportation and yes, delivery of hot meals. Daily visits keep clients connected to community news and doings and a monthly gift package delivers nutritional support, toiletries and other essentials. Travel for Impact is one of many Nongovernmental Organizations (NGOs) we work with. Your Deeper Africa trip includes a contribution to Travel for Impact. If you'd like to do more, you can bring along a few pieces of warm winter clothing to donate. If you'd like to do more, you can bring along new or gently used adult winter hats, gloves, and scarves. It gets cold in Botswana.
