

The Elephant Camp Victoria Falls

The local name of Victoria Falls is Mosi-oa-Tunya and means "the smoke that thunders."


The world's largest waterfall, Victoria Falls, stands at an imposing 355 feet (108 m) tall and is one of the seven natural wonders of the world. Fed by the Zambezi River system, it straddles the border between Zimbabwe and Zambia. The noise of the falls can be heard 25 miles (40 km) away.

DAYS 6, 7 & 8

Monachira Camp Moremi Game Reserve

Your camp is located on the Monachira Channel in the Moremi Game Reserve of the Okavango Delta, a permanent waterway attracting abundant wildlife, including large mammals such as elephants, lions and leopard, as well as semiaquatic antelope. It is very close to the Gudigwa heronries - a nesting ground for thousands of herons, egrets and storks.

Moremi is all about searching for big wildlife. The habitats are as diverse as the wildlife itself. Water-adapted antelopes and wary-eyed buffaloes spill out into floodplains, behind towering woodlands where leopards hide on the high branches. Dead trees cast silhouettes over elephant filled savannas which are just a stone's throw from papyrus-fringed channels stretching out to the delta beyond.

We've saved the best for last—the Makgadikgadi salt pans. A truly unique and unusual ecosystem, this is one of Africa's largest ephemeral wetlands. Once an ancient ocean—what remains is a large, flat, shimmering salt pan stretching for miles in every direction. The grass that grows in the pan is especially nutritious because of its mineral content, drawing wildlife from miles around. This is a magical place that turns into a surreal wonderland at sunset, with a night sky that's studded full of millions of stars. There is complete silence, a hard thing to find in our world.


Wildlife in Makgadikgadi is also unusual and unique. Habituated meerkats den in one area of the pans. At sunrise, watch them crawl from their den, stand and open their chests to the sun to raise their body

temperature, before scampering about in search of food. This is one of only two places in Botswana to view brown hyena. Quad bike out on the salt pan. Hang out with the meerkats. Walk with the famed San Bushmen as they show you how they, their grandfathers and grandmothers survived in this most austere environment. Plus wildlife viewing in a unique new world.



Their lifestyle remains rooted in Paleolithic traditions, suited to the harshness of th dry season in the Pans and Kalahari. Take a leisurely bush walk with San trackers to see how people survive and thrive in this landscape, and learn basic survival skills and plant identification tips.

The San have their own variant of the Khoisan language with its clicking consonants and they will teach you a few basic words and phrases. Months from now, back in your busy life, you will remember the people you met on this day and be amazed to recall how their typical weekday looks and feels compared to yours. Some weeks, you may wish to trade places.
