### DAY 2 Kwetu Nairobi

Full day with your guide exploring Nairobi. Late morning we'll bring you to the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage for a visit with the younger elephants.

The Sheldrick Orphanage adopts baby elephants who have lost their mothers to poaching. These orphaned elephants live, play and learn together under the compassionate watch of their inspiring human caretakers, who prepare them to return to the wild. Watch elephant feedings and mud baths and meet elephants less than four years of age. *Includes:* Swimming Pool WiFi

## DAYS 3, 4 & 5 Soroi Larsens Camp Samburu Reserve

Flight Departs | Nairobi Arrives | Samburu

Samburu has some unique animals for viewing rarely found together in other parks. The gerenuk is an antelope with a giraffe-like neck, adapted to browsing in bushes—a niche not exploited by most other animals. The Beisa oryx survives this hot climate by cooling the blood flowing to its brain, as it passes through capillaries in its nose. Other unique species in this incredible wildlife environment include the Reticulated giraffe, the Grevy zebra and the Somali ostrich. This part of Kenya has been on the forefront of research on elephant migration patterns and corridors. Dr. Iain Douglas-Hamilton and his Elephant Watch Camp are based in the area. Mapping elephant migration corridors, their GPS data helps to prevent conflicts between elephants and humans. Local farmers and pastoralists have an easier time protecting their crops, livestock and families because of the work done by Save the Elephants.

Prolific Lewa Wildlife Conservancy spans the sprawling plains north of Mt. Kenya and has been a popular subject of writers, photographers, conservationists and even celebrities the world over. Offering some of Kenya's best wildlife viewing in the Laikipia Plateau, including big cats, jackals and the largest concentration of Grevy's zebras left in Africa. It is also home to more than 130 Black and White rhino. Pioneering conservation efforts since the 1970s, it is now a globally-recognized successful rhino conservancy.

Spanning 35,000 acres, Olare Motorogi Conservancy was one of the first private conservancies in the Maasai Mara ecosystem. Founded in 2006 when 227 Maasai landowners partnered with conservationists, it now acts as a template for other Mara wildlife conservancies and a blueprint for the sustainability of the greater Mara ecosystems that are crucial to the survival of the great wildebeest migration.

Olare Motorogi offers unrivaled wildlife viewing in an intimate, private wilderness setting of rolling grassland, hills, escarpment, riverine forest and acacia woodland. In addition, the Conservancy delivers guaranteed income to the local community as well as protects their ancestral lands.
