See how these baby elephants connect with their caretakers in the Nairobi orphanage and how they prepare for reintegration into the wild at the Ithumba compound in Tsavo National Park. Meet researchers in elephant-dense Amboseli National Park. DAYS 1 & 2

Ololo Safari Lodge

Nairobi National Park

Upon clearing customs at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Kenya's bustling capital city of Nairobi, your Deeper Africa guide awaits you holding a Deeper Africa sign with your name on it. He will transport you to Ololo Safari Lodge in Nairobi National Park. Wake up in the park after a good night's sleep. Your Deeper Africa guide will be meeting you the following morning to take you to Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage.

The Sheldrick Orphanage adopts baby elephants who have lost their mothers to poaching. These orphaned elephants live, play and learn together under the compassionate watch of their inspiring human caretakers, who prepare them to return to the wild. Watch elephant feedings and mud baths and meet elephants less than four years of age.

DAYS 3 & 4

Elephants celebrate birth, have lifelong friendships, and mourn the death of family members.

Depart for small, yet spectacular Amboseli National Park in southern Kenya, known for its elephants. Meet and learn about these intelligent and sentient elephants, and view a variety of wildlife in the park's plains, acacia woodland, savannas, marshes and lake swamps.

Visit the Moss Research Station, where Cynthia Moss, author of *Echo of the Elephants*, and her Amboseli Elephant Research Project (AERP) team have spent more than 40 years studying some 1,500 elephants in 50 families.

Tawi Lodge, on a 6,000 acre private conservancy run in conjunction with the African Wildlife Foundation, offers incredible views of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Communities like those surrounding Tawi Lodge have been instrumental in allowing Amboseli's elephant population to slowly increase since the late 1970s. You support the communities and the elephants with your stay at Tawi Lodge.

DAYS 5 & 6

Ithumba Hill Camp Tsavo East National Park

Depart for Tsavo East National Park to stay in Sheldrick's Ithumba compound. Accommodations are comfortable and elephants are close. Learn more about the reintroduction program—many elephants have gone on to join wild herds in the area. Young elephants that aren't yet ready to rejoin the wild stay with their keepers here. Greet the young elephants as they return to the stockades to sleep.

The following visitation times act as a guideline:

6am - 8am: at the stockades

11am - 1pm: at the midday mud-bath

4pm - 6pm: at the stockades

Tsavo East is one of the world's biodiversity strongholds and provides great wildlife viewing, tracking and birdwatching in bush grasslands, open plains, acacia scrub and woodland ecosystems. The seasonal Tiva River, fringed by beautiful trees and flowing only during rainfall further upstream, is a must-see, as is Lesalau Dam, Ithumba's seasonal dam.

DAYS 7 & 8

Soroi Lions Bluff Lodge Tsavo National Park

Tsavo provides an opportunity to see many other wildlife species, particularly the unique Tsavo lion, which neither look nor behave like their Serengeti cousins. Adult males often lack a mane which would normally cause them to be shunned by females and bullied by other males. But here, maneless lions exist in all resident prides and this does not put the lions at a disadvantage. Requiring less water to cool themselves, they can travel longer and farther in search of females and prey. Tsavo prides are made up of single males with 4 to 10 adult females each, larger than the Serengeti's prides.

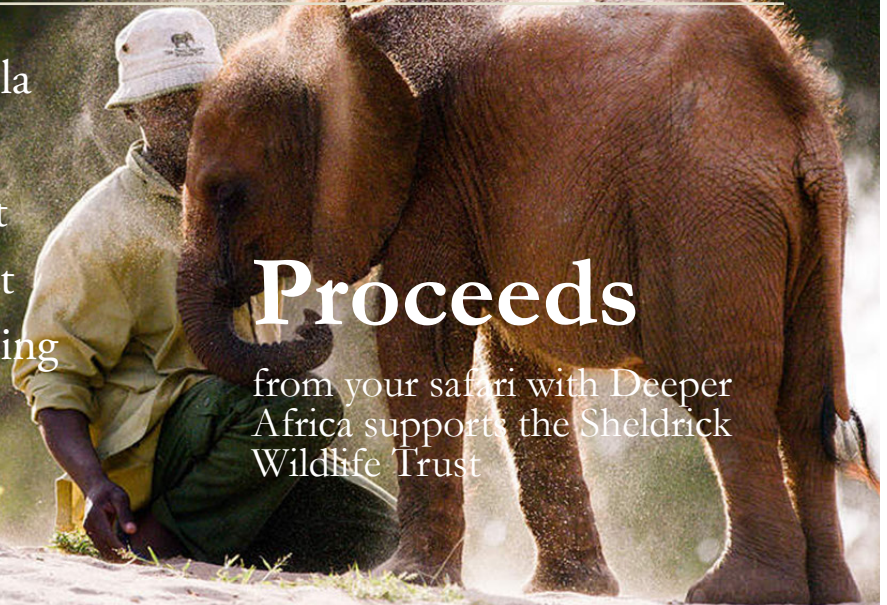
