# Manta Resort Pemba Island

With only 900 people living on Pemba Island this secluded paradise feels especially peaceful and restorative. Wake up and listen to the surf break on the turquoise Indian Ocean and watch the waves roll in. Walk, or perhaps dance, along the beach. Explore the sea in a kayak. Embark on a dhow boat to isolated sandbank islands that appear and disappear with the tides. Snorkel and scuba dive amongst the coral reef's hundreds of neon tropical fishes.

Above the sea, the main deck features a lounge and bathroom with a ladder leading up to the roof. On the roof is a second lounge area for sunbathing by day and stargazing by night, amongst the gentle sound of Indian Ocean waves. Below deck is where the real magic is. Completely surrounded by glass with nearly 360 degrees of fully-submerged aquatic viewing, watch a plethora of reef fish, octopi and spanish dancers swim by. The water is lit by the sun and a nighttime spotlight for a magical and adventurous feel, both day and night.

## Pemba Island

Help build Seles Primary School. Manta's local village is located very far from the town schools in Chake Chake and many children simply cannot attend. A local volunteer established a classroom in the village which has in turn inspired Manta Resort and its travelers to build a complete school: Seles. Option to donate supplies or building funds.

Snorkel to protect the reef. Manta Resort's house reef, directly in front of the lodge, lies within its conservation area. Hundreds of marine species and crystal clear tropical waters make this a must see for nature lovers. Enjoy and support the health of the reef when you choose to snorkel for \$25 per person. All revenues go directly to local marine conservation area committees and wardens.

Support the Shamba (farm). Local farmers have been given land to cultivate and harvest fresh fruit, herbs and vegetables for the Manta Resort and to be sold at the local

market for additional income. The farm enables Manta to employ five local farmers.
