

# Beho Beho

## Nyerere National Park

Make the journey to the Nyerere National Park via bush flight. Take in the aerial view of Nyerere’s three mighty rivers – the Rufiji, Kilombera, and the Great Ruaha, winding across the land below. Your guide from Beho Beho awaits you at the bush airstrip, or Beho Beho International Airport, as the locals call it. Beho Beho was the first camp established in Selous and it sits in one of its most wildlife rich areas. From your own private cottage you’ll have open views of elephants and hippos wandering in the gorge below. There’s a scope on the porch that allows you to watch them up close as they visit the watering holes below the camp.

Early morning is the best time to see the estimated 750,000 mammals in the reserve, including some of the largest populations of elephants, crocodile, buffalo, hippo, and wild dog. Selous was declared a World Heritage site by the United Nations in 1982 but the number of visitors is still fewer than 5,000 a year. This lack of mass tourism ensures a true wilderness experience. Wildlife viewing in Selous is less dense and requires patience – but that’s what gives it its charm. Tanzania changed the name of the park to Nyerere in 2019 in honor of their independence president.
