



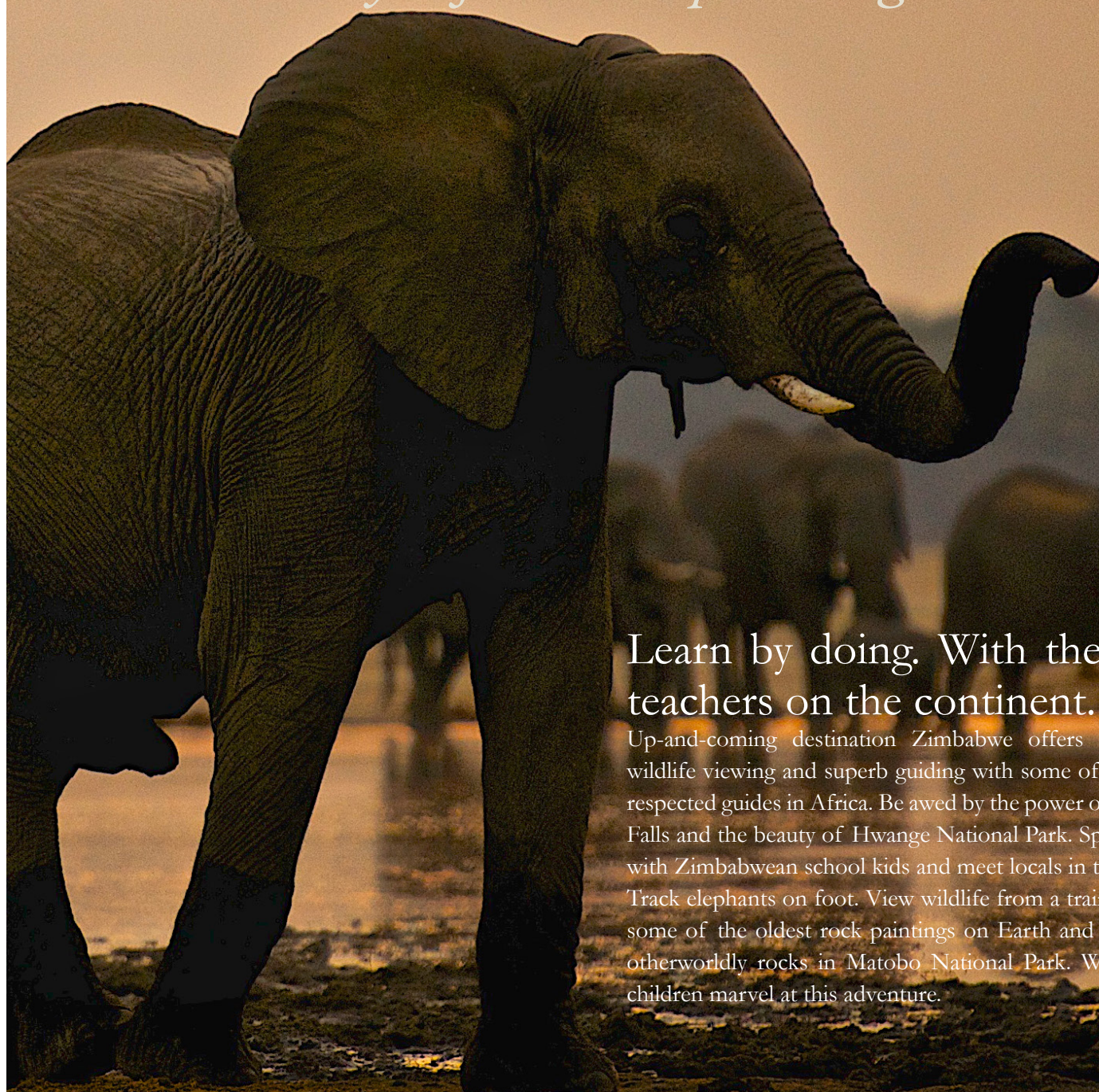

Matobo Hills, a landscape of granite towers and sheltering caves, teems with wildlife and contains more than 200 species of trees. Home to people for 500,000 years and declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2003, its ancient rock paintings, stone tools, pottery, oral traditions and shrines tell stories of hope, strife and spirituality.

Explore and climb the granite “whalebacks,” “castle kopjes,” and “balancing rocks” towering above the mahogany forest. Tour ancient rock art with your guide.

Track white and black rhino on foot with your guide and an expert local tracker.

Go with your guide on the “My Beautiful Home” bicycle tour as you ride through the local village that invites you to marvel in the beauty and embrace the essence of each home. As you ride away, you will cherish the remarkable diversity that makes each dwelling a testament to the village’s creativity and identity.

Claiming the world’s highest concentration of rock art, Matobo houses at least 3,000 rock art sites—some more than 10,000 years old.

Paintings depict ancient San people dancing, running and hunting. Giraffes, elephants, antelopes and rhino running, feeding and playing are also portrayed on the rock faces.

Mother Africa Trust

Matobo Hills, Zimbabwe

Proceeds

from your visit to Amalinda go to community and conservation programs.

Since 2009, Mother Africa Trust has been working with Amalinda Lodge to build community infrastructure, such as classrooms, teachers colleges and waiting rooms for expecting mothers, as well as fund conservation initiatives and anti-poaching. The Trust has brought electricity into schools and clinics and is currently assisting in the construction of a new primary school in Matobos for 200 children that currently walk more than 5 miles to get to the nearest school. The Trust is also dedicated to improving the living conditions and sustainability of disadvantaged communities around Hwange National Park and Matobos by awarding college scholarships, bringing people together through sports and events, funding school field trips and environmental cleanup campaigns. During the drought of 2016, the Trust was able to feed 923 children a meal each day for six months, and has contributed immensely towards the Matobo Rhino fence project to help protect endangered rhinos.

DAYS 4 & 5

Camelthorn Lodge Hwange National Park

Hwange National Park is Zimbabwe's largest national park and one of Africa's most rewarding. It was granted Game Reserve status in 1928 and proclaimed a national park in 1961.

Renowned for its incredible diversity of wildlife, it has more varieties of mammal and bird species than any other national park in Zimbabwe. More than 100 species of mammals (including 44,000 elephants) and more than 400 species of birds reside here. Botswana, Hwange and Zambia form the Kavango Zambezi Trans Frontier Conservation Area (KAZA TFCA) which is home to the world's largest contiguous elephant population. The park's southern areas feature deep Kalahari sands and hardwood forests of Zambezi teak, ancient lakebeds and large savannah grasslands with acacia and leadwood trees.

DAYS 6, 7 & 8

Victoria Falls Safari Lodge Victoria Falls Zambezi National Park

Your first adventure with your guide is a walking tour of Victoria Falls. The Falls stand 355 feet (108 meters) tall and is one of the seven wonders of the world. Fed by the Zambezi River system, it straddles the border between Zimbabwe and Zambia. The noise of the falls can be heard 25 miles (40 km) away.

Head to the Wild Horizons Elephant Sanctuary to learn more about elephant conservation and the plight of

these majestic gentle giants. End with the unique Art with Elephants program that has you painting elephants under the guidance of a local artist while they graze just beyond your easel.

The local name of Victoria Falls is *Mosi-oa-Tunya* and means “the smoke that thunders.”
