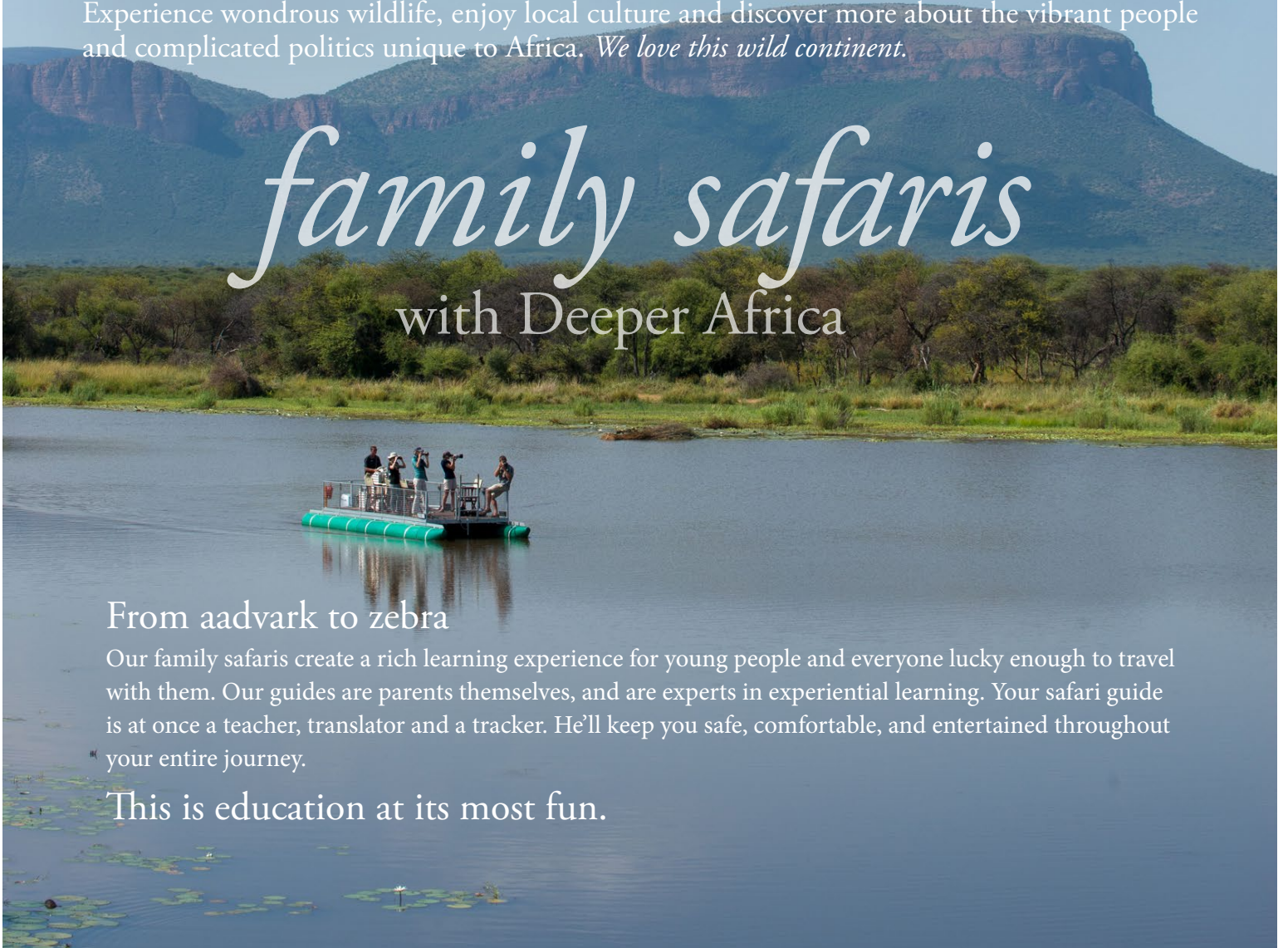

Kwandwe is a private game reserve, a refuge for endangered species: 54,000 acres (218 sq. km) of depleted farmland restored to pristine wilderness through enlightened public/private collaboration and meticulous science. That's a little over 1,000 acres (4 sq. km) of wilderness for each of you. Options include two game drives every day--nature walks with an armed ranger or a big-game walking safari scouting for rhino, elephant and buffalo with a tracker and an armed ranger.

You have a family suite with a Land Cruiser piloted by a ranger to take you everywhere. After a day in

the bush, come home to the plunge pool, a cocktail or a sundowner boat ride and dinner in the understated luxury of the lodge. EcCa offers many fun extras, from kite building to amazing scavenger hunts.
