Camp Hwange

Hwange National Park

Hwange is huge: over 5,000 square miles (12.9 thousand square kilometers) of subtropical thorn and sand flats and short grass savanna. It's a dry land sustained by enhanced waterholes that use solar-powered pumps to provide year-round water for the camp's beloved elephant population. Camp Hwange is a simpler, traditional camp that embodies safari values. You're here to study wildlife at close range, often on foot, made possible by guides that take this experience seriously. Lewis' tracking skills lead to uncommon encounters enriched by explanations and stories that will deepen your understanding of the web of life in Africa.

Mana Pools National Park

From Hwange board a bush plane and fly further north on the Zambezi to the place where seasonal rains flood from the river to form the Mana Pools. This, too, is Zimbabwe. Untouched wilderness sheathed in water, with the green peaks of Zambia beyond. Expect impressive diversity and long walks with Lewis at your side sharing tracking tips, insights and lore. Maybe a catered picnic. And an afternoon of closely guided canoeing, then porting out to enjoy a streamside gin and tonic while parsing all you have seen and heard.

Chilo Gorge Lodge Gonarezhou National Park

Say goodbye to Lewis this morning. You fly next to Gonarezhou National Park down in the southeast corner of Zimbabwe. Here you meet Clive Stockil, your second Zimbabwe Professional Safari Guide, for a deep dive into one of the last true wilderness spaces on the continent. Clive was born here and grew up learning to track alongside Shangaan friends. He knows the nobility and the struggles embedded in Zimbabwe's rich history. He's been instrumental in making responsible tourism part of the country's success in combating poaching and preserving wild lands. He's a modest man who will teach you how to quietly sharpen your senses, while sharing how he lives—as he says, “on the edge of serenity.” This is Africa for purists, a simple, comfortable lodge. A base for profound discovery.
