From the river's edge to the depths of Lake Kariba—an eerily beautiful liquid landscape embracing skeletal mopane trees preserved by the waters that drowned them in the 50s, when the dam was built on the Zambezi River. This national park is run by African Parks, an NGO with a mission: to protect and improve African parklands vital to conservation and climate change mitigation. For you, this means an abundance of elephants. Pods of snorting hippos. Maybe even a crash of black rhinos—an uncommon privilege to observe. It means days of blissful immersion. 
