DAYS 1, 2 & 3

Mana River Camp Mana Pools National Park

No better place to unplug than here, where just-right comforts make roughing-it easy. You are camped at the river's edge, where you wake to a flourish of bird song and attack a pile of pancakes as you plan your day. Land cruiser or walking safari? Lewis has an uncanny ability to take you deeper and get you closer, and a gift for explaining everything. Canoeing? Head out onto a sheet of sky-blue water for a couple of hours—or a full day of paddling as you quietly spy on wildlife. Thrills are pretty much guaranteed, interrupted only by an elegant riverside picnic set up for you around a distant bend.

DAYS 4, 5 & 6

Changa Camp Matusadona National Park

From the river's edge to the depths of Lake Kariba—an eerily beautiful liquid landscape embracing skeletal mopane trees preserved by the waters that drowned them in the 50s, when the dam was built. Count on remarkable wildlife sightings because you're with Lewis in Matusadona. This national park is run by African Parks, an NGO with a mission: to protect and improve African parklands vital to conservation and climate change mitigation. For you, this means an abundance of elephants. Pods of snorting hippos. Maybe even a crash of black rhinos—an uncommon privilege to observe. It means days of blissful immersion. And a camp that makes you very much a part of this world.

African Parks

When you travel with Deeper Africa, we connect you to people and programs that make a difference. Your days in Matusadona make you a real-time, real-dollar contributor to the work of African Parks, work that keeps pristine wild spaces experience-rich and corruption free, including support for the highly trained African Parks rangers who keep parks safe for wildlife and visitors alike.

Matusadona is the first protected area in Zimbabwe to fall under the management of African Parks. A twenty year agreement has been put in place. African Parks is charged with implementing management strategies to secure the park and restore wildlife populations, to unlock its ecological, social and economic value and to enable communities in the area to derive long term benefits from the park.



DAYS 7, 8, 9 & 10

Deteema Camp Hwange National Park

Your camp rests on a slight rise surrounded by towering teak and mopane trees, above natural springs that provide year-round water for large concentrations of animals. Set out with Lewis and see how your spotting and tracking skills have sharpened. Because you're so close to a natural watering hole, you will also catch some eye-popping and heartwarming moments without leaving camp, which is nice because amenities here, and the warm welcome provided by camp staff, invite you to pause and engage.

Now the Zambezi rallies for a thunderous encore where the river makes its famous plunge. Lewis shows you the falls and leads you into mists that shelter a rainforest thick with ferns and fragrance (170 floral species). This is Eden. The kind of Eden that offers a small boutique hotel as a base to explore streets with markets, galleries and shop stalls stocked with indigenous artisanal crafts. Your hosts will advise you on must-see stops, including the stately Victoria Falls Hotel, where you can time travel back to the 20s over high tea, or a leisurely lunch, as you reflect on all you have seen and done.
