

DAY 2

Kensington Place Cape Town

This morning take a driving tour of Cape Town with a Deeper Africa guide. Begin with a tour of Table Mountain to soak up panoramic vistas of the Mother City and the surrounding oceans, weather permitting. Pay the cable car fee direct.

We'll also drive to the Company Gardens and then wander through learning about the history of this amazing garden created by the Dutch East Indies Company in 1650, as a maritime replenishment station. Afterwards we'll visit the South African Museum and then climb onto the Castle of Good Hope, also built by the Dutch. This is the oldest colonial building in the country.

During the drive we'll pass the Houses of Parliament, the Grand Parade and City Hall - where Nelson Mandela first addressed South Africans after his release. The Grand Parade is a public square that has played a significant role in South African history.

To end the morning, our guide will drop you off at the vibrant Victoria &Alfred Waterfront as the end of your tour. You can then easily explore the restaurants and pubs to select a lunch spot, pay direct. There is shopping available, as







Cape Town

This afternoon continue your exploration of Cape Town joining a local guide from the Bo-Kaap neighborhood. The Bo-Kaap tour is the oldest suburb in South Africa. This is a walking tour that takes you to a local's home to enjoy a traditional treat and a cup of South Africa's famous rooibos tea. The host will entertain you with stories of this historical neighborhood, its people, and its cultures. Venture down the most-photographed street in Cape Town with its brightly colored 17th century houses, cobble stone streets, Muslim shrines, and beautiful mosques. You'll stop at the famed spice shop, Atlas, where you will smell the heady aromas of spices used in everyday Cape Malay cooking

The tour ends at the Bo-Kaap Hub living heritage museum, a beautiful exhibition and explanation of traditions and the history of these traditions in Bo-Kaap.







DAY 6

La Cotte Cottages Franschhoek

Today venture out to discover the best of Franschhoek – from wine farms to galleries to history. Our guide will pick you up at 9:00am.

Start out in Franschoek village, learning about the history of the region, and visiting some of the best local galleries on foot. We'll have you at Everard Read, Ebony, and IS Art Gallery. Enjoy morning coffee at Terbodore Coffee Roasters in town. The rest of the day is tailored to your preferences:






