Babylonstoren

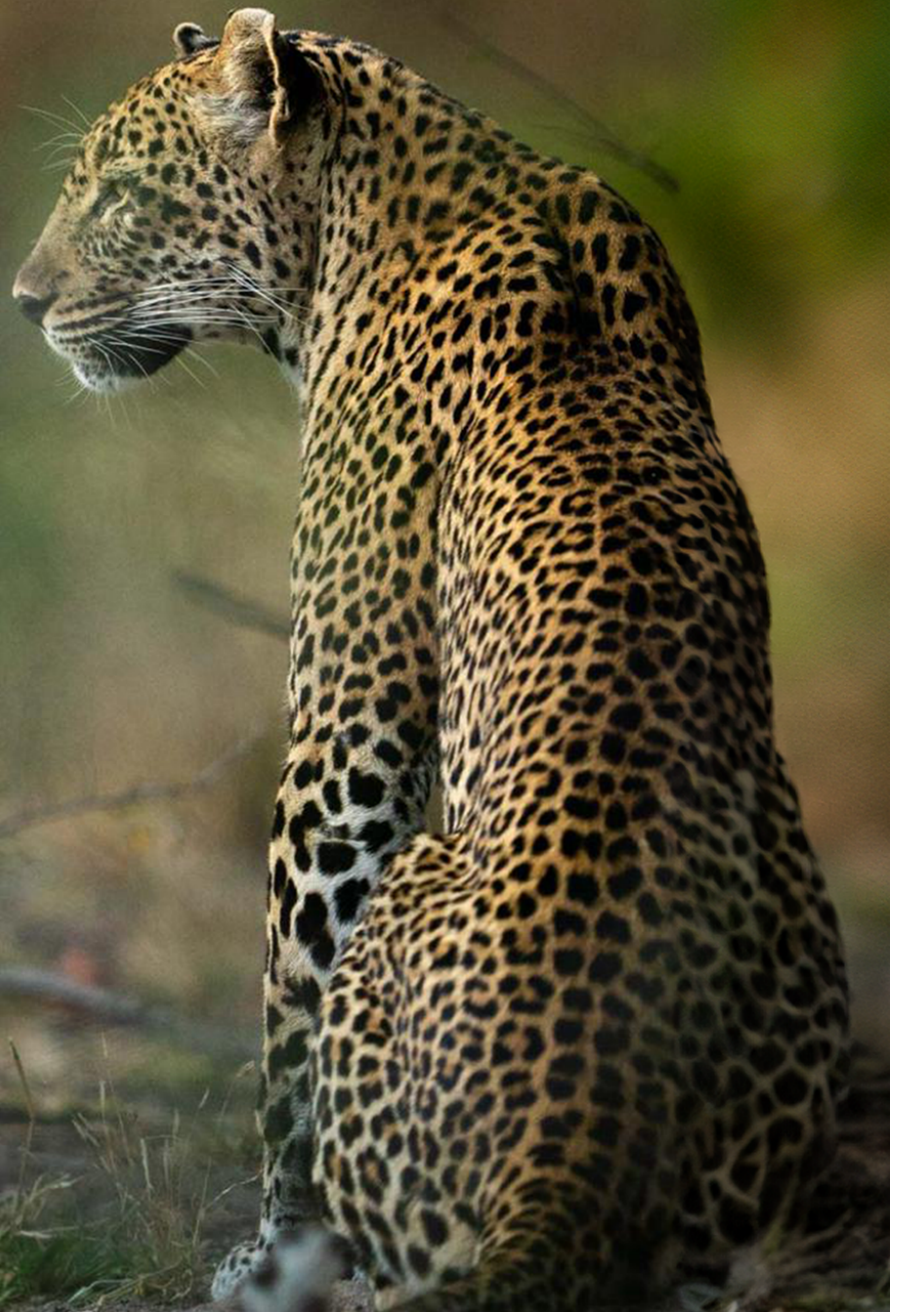
