




DAY 2


Simba Farm Lodge Kilimanjaro National Park

This morning we'll have you up on the mountain early to start your hike onto Kilimanjaro. Your Kilimanjaro guide will start the day with a briefing about your day's hike up the mountain. He'll have a lunch for you to carry in your backpack. We'll take on the mountain at your pace, slowly, our goal being Shira I camp on the Lemosho Route. You'll see the Shira Plateau landscape, one of the world's largest high-altitude plateaus. This is considered one of the most beautiful routes on Kilimanjaro.

DAYS 6, 7 & 8

Olkeri Camp Tarangire National Park

Flight #1 (Day 6)
Departs | Kilimanjaro
Arrives | Kuro Airstrip

Drive out from Mkomazi to Kilimanjaro Airport to catch a flight to your next ecosystem, Tarangire National Park. This environment is a mix of open grassland savannas, acacia woodlands, a massive wetland and the Tarangire River, plus the presence of large ancient baobab trees. The river and wetlands support a high density of elephants and migratory populations of wildebeest and zebra, giraffe, lions and many bird species. Nighttime drives and walking safaris are allowed in this dynamic wilderness area. In fact, you'll be heading out for your second day in Tarangire on foot guided toward your small private bush camp, called a "fly camp" in East Africa. Enjoy dinner cooked over the fire by the camp cook while

getting a lesson on the southern hemisphere stars from your guide

You're in for some great elephant viewing in Tarangire. This park boasts one of the largest and most conspicuous elephant populations in East Africa. Look for them congregating along the Tarangire River or crossing single file across the roads. Numerous baobabs, an ancient type of tree, can be seen dotting the landscape of the park. As you settle in for a sundowner, the dark silhouettes of towering baobabs come alive against the background of the fiery African sky.



DAYS 6, 7 & 8

Olkeri Camp Tarangire National Park

Set off this morning on foot to enjoy the wilderness and to make your way to your private bush camp. Fly camping is an overnight experience that places you in the wilderness within a light camp where you sleep in a net tent that keeps out creepy crawlies, but which lets in the spectacular light of the infinite star canopy. This is the ultimate immersive experience that exposes you and your senses to bush life after dark.

The campfire is the focal point of the fly camp, where you eat your meals, socialize, tell stories and share knowledge and experiences. However, a back-to-basics camp does

not mean a lack of comfort. On the contrary, we have kept a few luxuries for you: think drifting off to sleep and being hugged by warm duvets and soft down pillows; a basin filled with hot water and soft towels to dry your face; and generous dining on wholesome food served with a cold beer or a cool glass of wine. This experience will take you deep into the wilderness. Today you'll do your activities on foot allowing you to experience the bush as a participant rather than as a mere observer. Still, a vehicle is on-site and at your disposal should you need (or want) it.

Arusha National Park

Next move to a new and different ecosystem – a forest ecosystem at the base of Mount Meru. Koroi Forest Camp is nestled in Arusha National Park, a quilt of habitats between the towering peaks of Mount Kilimanjaro and Mount Meru. This dramatic landscape is shaped by the ash cone and cliff faces of Mount Meru that frame the park's volcanic crater lates and calderas. When dawn breaks in this world the calls of colobus monkeys, turacos, and hornbills echo through the trees. Wildlife often wanders along the forest paths and into the glade – duikers, bushbuck, giraffes, buffalos, and elephants join the day. At night, wood owls, nightjars, and even the distant growl of a leopard add a different rhythm to the forest. As the darkness deepens, nocturnal creatures like African civets, bushy-tail mongooses,

bushpigs, and buffaloes come to forage in the glade under the starts. The glades are created by elephants or fallen trees, kept open by grazing buffalos, waterbucks and bushpigs. They create lush pastures where wildflowers thrive in the open, sunlit areas — with lots of butterflies.

The activities in this ecosystem are endless. You'll have great wildlife viewing in the park's savannas, guided walks in the safari and forest ecosystem, plus a peaceful and scenic canoe safari along the shores of Momella Lake. You'll have the opportunity to view buffalo, bushbucks, giraffes, hippos and many water birds that live close to the water. We'll have a meal or two in our secret enchanted locations: a hand-picked nest to a forest stream or waterfall, overlooking a hidden glade or perhaps under the looming canopy of ancient trees.

We'll also take you on a scenic drive up the mountain, traversing the diverse vegetation zones of the Mount Meru Forest, entering one of the gorges where water cascades off the mountain. We'll walk along the course of the river, enjoying the cool stream and beautiful rock formations. Orchids and epiphytes are rich on this walk, as is the bird life. The waterfall awaits.
