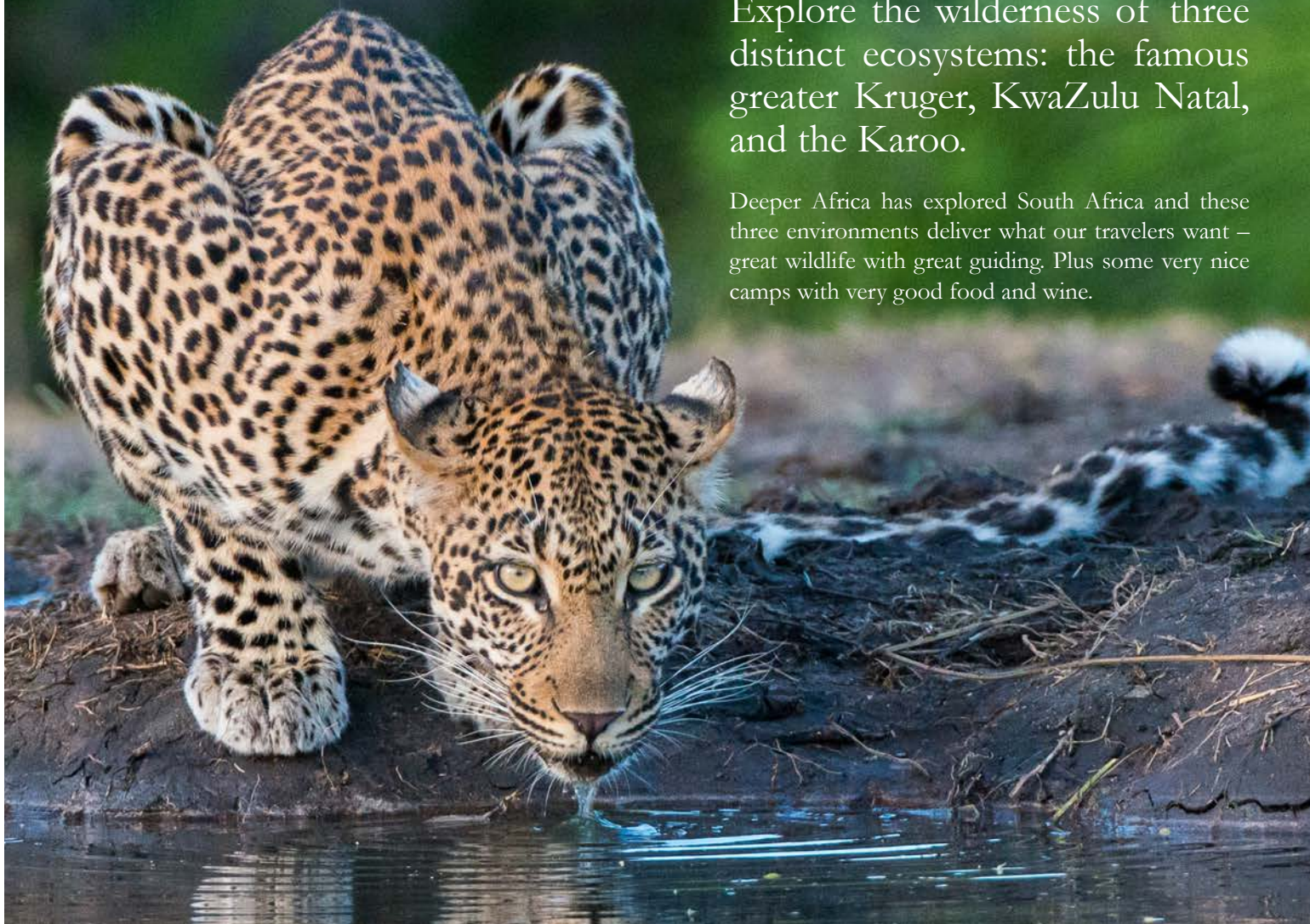

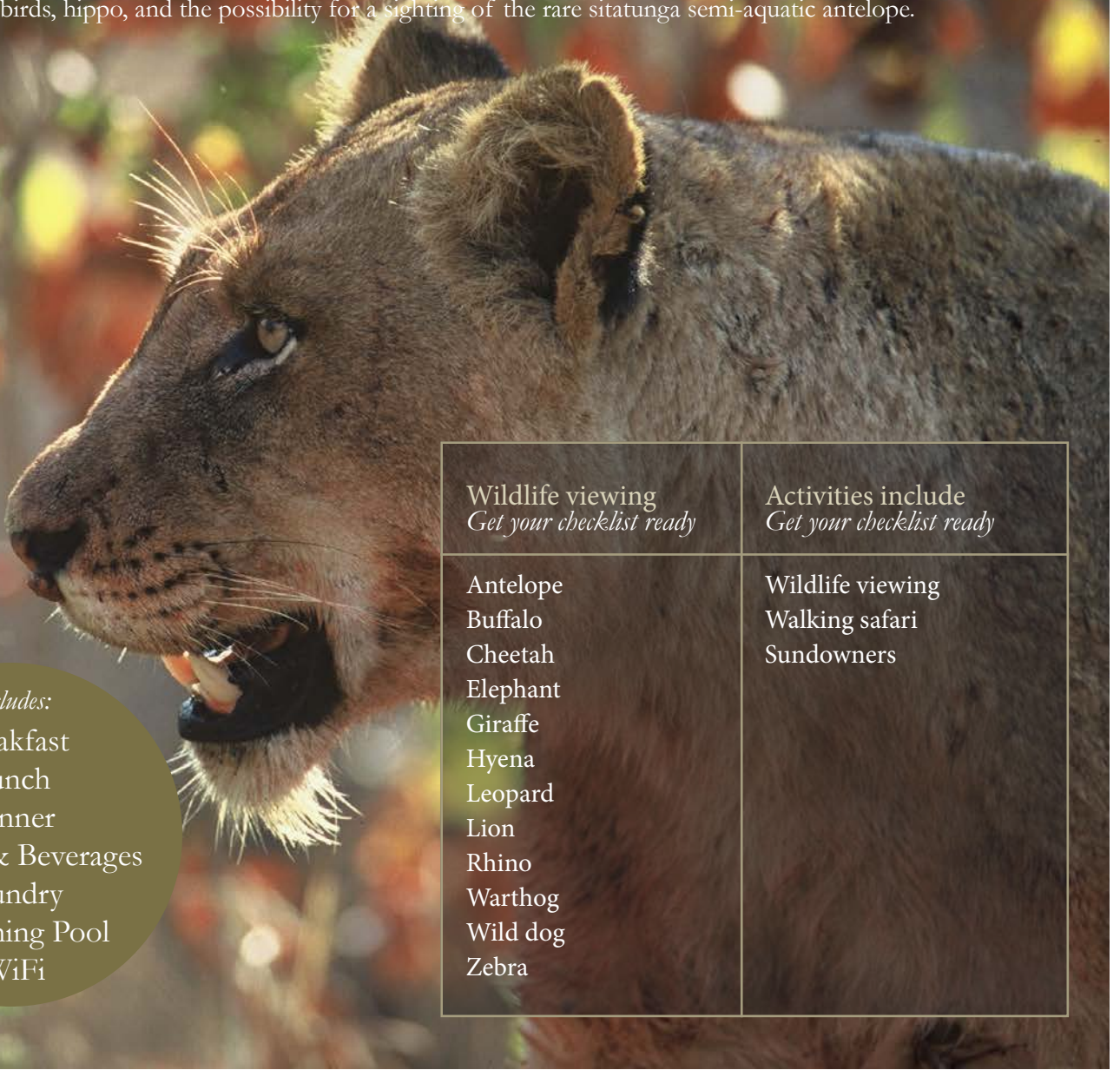

DAYS 2 & 3

Dulini River Lodge Sabi Sand Reserve

Great wildlife and exceptional guiding are the hallmarks of Duluni, a sector of Sabi Sand Reserve with open borders into the Kruger National Park. The perennial Sand River runs through the reserve bringing lifesaving water to the lowveld, as well as beautiful riverine landscapes. It is an area famous for the wide diversity of wildlife including the Big Five: lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo.

Lots of big cat sightings including leopard, plus an additional predator – wild dogs. Duluni guides are very familiar with the wildlife in the reserve and their interpretive skills are excellent. They track their lions and leopards on a daily basis, so sightings are frequent. These guys are superb. Plus the water and reed beds of the Sabi River are a major draw for birds, hippo, and the possibility for a sighting of the rare sitatunga semi-aquatic antelope.

Manyoni Reserve is wilderness with a well-trained unique guiding team. Their Shangaan trackers use traditional tracking skills following fresh paw prints, drag marks, and tree scratches. This allows you to see leopards behaving naturally hunting, drinking, and scent marking, not just spotlighted in trees. Guides also maintain ethical distances while being able to off-road when needed. Manyoni Reserve was established to reintroduce rhinos so the reserve has both black and white rhinos. Terrain is varied which gives rhino a range of habitats and space for them to wander naturally.

Samara Karoo will be waiting to pick you up and drive northwest from the city into the countryside that makes up the famous Karoo – a vast semi-desert region in South Africa covering over one-third of the country. The name comes from a Khoisan word for land of thirst. This is a unique semi-arid biome on Earth shaped by ancient geology and highly adapted to plants and animals. Because of its isolation, many species evolved here and nowhere else. Preservation of the Karoo is a global conservation priority. Enjoy the warm days, clear skies, breathtaking scenery, and the freedom to explore one of South Africa’s most extraordinary landscapes.
